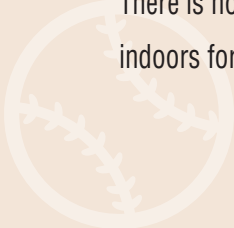




CAMP FACILITIES

YOUTH FUNDAMENTALS CAMPS

For boys in grades: 4-6
12:30 – 2:30 p.m.

These camps are intended to cover all aspects of the fundamentals of the game. Spend time on hitting, fielding, throwing, baserunning, and a specialty period to focus on a specific position on defense, including pitching and catching. The goal of this camp is to teach repeatable fundamentals in an appropriate group size, and maximize our time to balance instruction and repetition.

*Participants are encouraged to bring their own bat if possible.

WINTER PITCHING/CATCHING & INFIELD CAMPS

For boys in grades: 7-12
1:15-2:45 p.m.

These camps are designed to isolate your specific position in the field and break down its components. Pitchers will focus on mechanics, ball location, changing of speed, ways to increase velocity, and injury prevention. Catchers learn blocking and receiving, set-up and stance, throwing and controlling the game. Infielders will receive instruction on both general fielding concepts as well as position specific instruction. All position groups will be separated based on age and skill level.

*Catchers gear will NOT be provided. If you catch, you will need to bring your own gear.

WINTER HITTING CAMPS

For boys in grades: 7-12
3-5 p.m.

Coaches will break down each individual swing and teach proper ways to be successful at the plate. Age groups and skill levels will be separated to optimize the overall experience. All participants will receive a multitude of swings at different instructional stations.

*Participants are encouraged to bring their own bat to camp if possible.
