CAMP STAFF:

UW-La Crosse Head Coach

Jason Murphy directs all camps. Murphy comes to UW-L after four years as head women's soccer coach and director of athletics at Marian University. The Sabres compiled a 33-12-2 Northern Athletic Conference (NAC) record under Murphy, who was selected the league's coach of the year in 2011. Murphy currently serves on the National Collegiate Athletic Association (NCAA) Division



III Women's Soccer National Committee after being a member of the NCAA Regional Advisory Committee from 2011-13. Murphy has earned his National and Advanced National coaching licenses from the National Soccer Coaches Association of America (NSCAA) as well as his NSCAA State and Regional Goalkeeper licenses and has served as a soccer staff coach since 2012 with the Wisconsin Olympic Development Program. Prior to becoming Marian's head coach, Murphy served as an assistant women's soccer coach at the University of Chicago (III.) for two years and at UW-Stevens Point for two seasons. He helped guide the University of Chicago (III.) to a 28-10-3 record as the Maroons qualified for the NCAA III Championships in both seasons.

Nicole Hirsch completed her first year as an assistant coach for UW-L in 2013 and served as the team's recruiting coordinator from November 2013 to March of 2014. A four-year letter winner at the UW-Milwaukee, Hirsch was on four Horizon League Conference championship teams (2007, 2008, 2009, 2010). The Panthers also won three tournament titles (2008, 2009, 2010) and earned bids to the NCAA Division I Tournament. She currently coaches at La Crosse Central High School and is a WI ODP coaching staff member as well. She currently holds an USSF National C coaching license.

Joe Czerniak joined the UW-L Coaching Staff this spring soon after the hiring of Head Coach Jason Murphy. Czerniak has been the La Crosse Central boys and girls coach for eight seasons. He has won over 100 matches at Central, including a Mississippi Valley Conference Championship in 2008. Czerniak was also conference Coach of the Year in 2008, 2011, and 2013. He has coached a C1 club team for Mississippi Valley Storm since 2011 and earned his National "D" coaching license from Wisconsin Youth Soccer Association in 2007.

UW-L soccer team members will also serve as instructors.
